Every Day Counts (EDC) is designed to identify and deploy innovation aimed at shortening project delivery, enhancing the safety of our roadways, and improving environmental sustainability. It will focus on the deployment of a finite set of initiatives.

FHWA Administrator Victor Mendez just launched this initiative. NACE members will be participating on several of the technology deployment areas. Attached outlines a summary of those initiatives. Over the coming months FHWA will be working on implementing the initiatives. A series of "Innovation Summits" will be held in the fall sponsored by FHWA and AASHTO to engage key personnel in state and local transportation agencies around the nation.
